The Simplicity of the Gospel...Back to the Basics (Col.2)

Today we live in a very complicated busy complexwith opinions and input across the
board concerning, among other things, the and of life. With so many ideas and
answers it may seem odd if not simplistic to say the answer, the complete answer and the
answer to all of life's questions is Is it really that simple? Is He truly that we
need for this life and in the future?
Well, that's what the Bible says and that's what Jesus claimed. You see Jesus claimed to God
and claimed to be the Savior. In Col. 2, Paul makes an amazing statement concerning Christ. "In
whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge." That's a bold statement! Paul says all
wisdom all knowledge all that wisdom and knowledge have to offer is in Jesus Christ.
Really?
Absolutely!! You might say, "isn't that just a religious viewpoint?" No. This is an authoritative
statement made in God's word and the very next verse says, Col. 2:4 "I tell you this so that no one may
deceive you by fine - sounding arguments." Don't let try to take the truth from you!
Everything that has real value, real meaning in lifethis life and the life to come is found in
Heb. 10:14 says, "He made perfect forever those who are set apart to Him." Col. 2:10 says, "and you
have been given fullness in Christ" In Him you are made!
Four Areas that Clutter the Simplicity of the of Christ
Four areas that Paul warns could "take you captive" (vs.8), could deceive you by "fine –sounding
arguments" (vs.4). When he wrote to the Corinthians he said "I'm very worried about you" because
false teachers were coming in and confusing them and in 2Cor.11:3 he said, "I am afraid that just as
Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere
and pure devotion to Christ." Here in Colossians Paul points out 4 areas that assault the simplicity of
Christ and the Sufficiency of Christ and ultimately rob Him of His glory and "plunder" you.
I (vs. 8): Paul has just said to the Colossians 1:15-22, so Christ is and Paul
says in 2:6 continue to live "in". He is all sufficient. It is not Christ plus something that makes you complete. You complete in Christ.
A. Paul calls man's philosophy "hollow and deceptive" based on the principles of the
This refers to whatever systems men inventideologies philosophies, psychologies, theories of
religion. Everyone has their idea of God and truth and life and morality. From authors, to
playwrights, to movie producers to talk show hosts to psychologists to religious leaders. Men with
high coming up with their own idea of truth or today saying there really is no truth, no
truth. You have your truth and I have my truth. Paul says don't be taken!
B. Human "truth" is based on "this world". If you want to know divine truth, supernatural
truthdon't go to a human 1 Cor. 2:14. And notice what Col 1:13 says in light of their
faith in Christ (1:3). He says there are two kingdoms, two kings, darkness/light, satan/Christ. 1 Vs.
21 says once we were enemies now reconciled, redeemed, forgiven without blemish and free from
accusation.

Human truth is! It's origins are the "basic principles of this world" It's men
with high IQ's confined in their time/space box Nobody gets out. The only way we will know
anything is if God comes in. Did He ever do that? Jn. 3:13.
So mankind is earthbound and comes up with his truth. It's "baby talk", it's elementary, it's
"basic", rudimentary based on knowledge. It's like when brilliant minds thought the world
was flat for centuries. Paul says, "don't be taken captive!"
was flat for centuries. I dur says, don't be taken captive.
II: The 2 nd assault on the sufficiency of Christ is religion. Col 2:16. Don't
allow yourself to be judged as somehow guilty before God because you don't enough stuff. You
do enough to be righteous! That's Christ came (vs. 13-15). Ceremony and ritual
won't do it. Listen, these were "shadows" of the things to come. The Sabbath pointed to our ultimate
rest in Christ is our Sabbath. These were figures, shadows of something not yet come but
retaining the figure, full IN
HIM!!
III. The third area that can intimidate Christian into believing their faith in Christ alone is somehow
incomplete is The thought is somehow really people connect with God through
some special experience or feeling.
A. Some count on their vow of poverty"false humility".
B. Some count on the worship of angels-believing you can transcend this life and touch the throne
of God by with angels.
1. The Essenes (a Jewish sect) in Paul's day.
2. Roman Catholicism-A whole theology on the veneration of angels.
3. Some count on visions, on things they've seen, secret revelations
Paul says "don't let them disqualify you for the prize" Don't let them you. It will rob
you of your spiritual life and your reward because you will trust in something than Christ
alone and it robs Him of His glory. If you give authority to anything other than the written word and
the Incarnate Living Word (Christ) you detract from His You are complete in Him!!
Today we see televangelists speaking of visions and revelations and talking to angels and "such a
person goes into great detail about what he has seen and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle
notions." Col 2:18. They've lost connection with the Head of the Church, All of a
sudden Christ isn't the issue but they are with their mystical experiences and visions. You cannot
exalt Christ and yourself at the same time.
IV. The last warning Paul makes is Man made commands and teaching concerning what to
touch, what to eat, self flagulation and harsh treatment of the body. It is only the commandments and
teaching of men giving the appearance of wisdom and results in humility but lacks
value. Vs. 20 says "you died with Christ to the world's rules" You therefore live in a new world a new
kingdom. Vs. 13 says "God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us our sins."
Dan't submit yourself to the world's rules again they're
Don't submit yourself to the world's rules again-they're! Anything you do to your
body is worthless in terms of spiritual benefit other than submitting your body in obedience to the
truth of God. Everything you ever need is in Christ and Christ To imagine that you need
Christ plus human wisdom, keeping external rules, speaking in a heavenly language, seeing visions,
interacting with angels, inflicting pain on yourself, living in self denial is allowing yourself to be "taken
captive". All you need is Christ! In Him is complete forgiveness, victory over sin, redemption, life, the
new birth, peace, truth, a new nature, a new heart, adoption into the family of God. In Him you are
! All truth, all wisdom, all knowledge, all understanding, all satisfaction, all purpose, all
deliverance, all strength, all comfort and all eternal hope is in Christ. To have Him is to have
These are called "the unsearchable riches of Christ."
